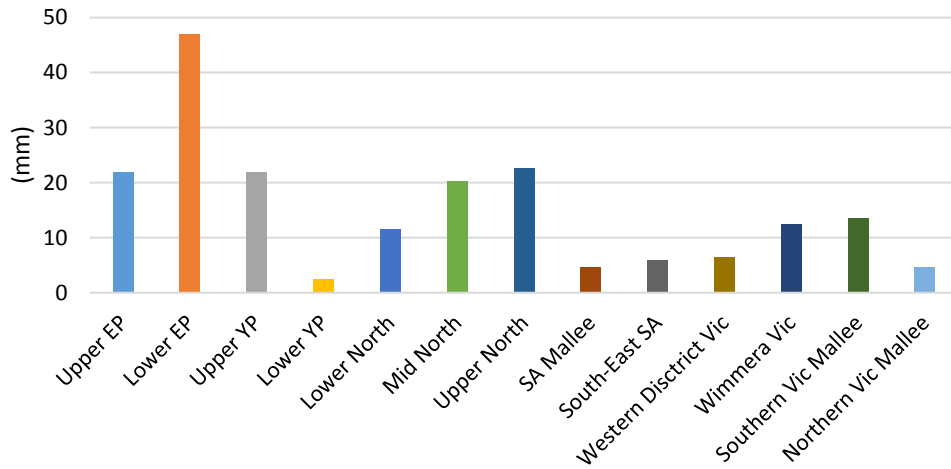
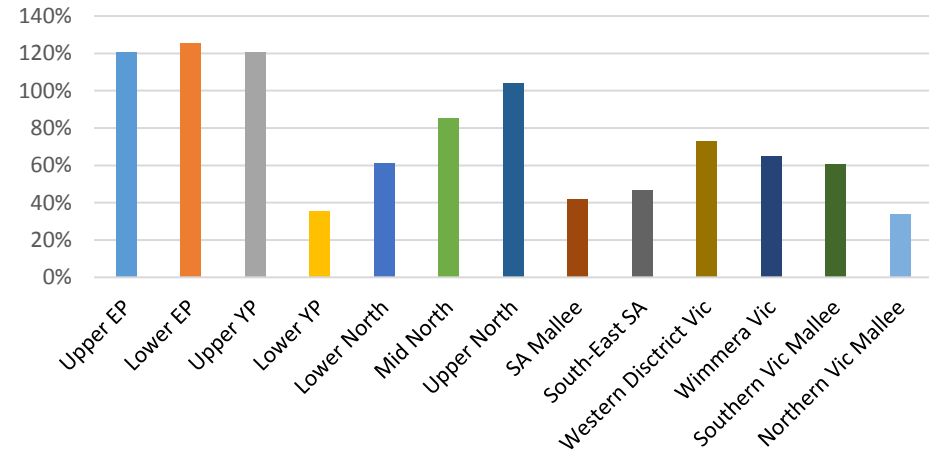


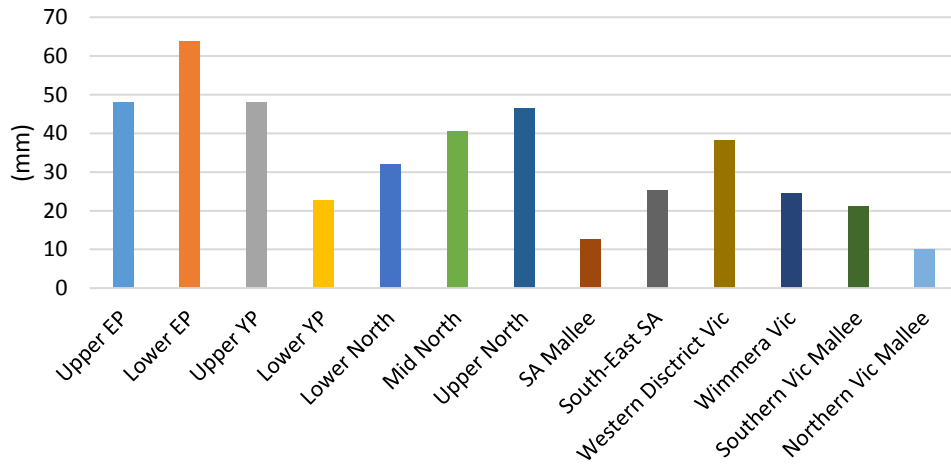
Rainfall Last 7 days



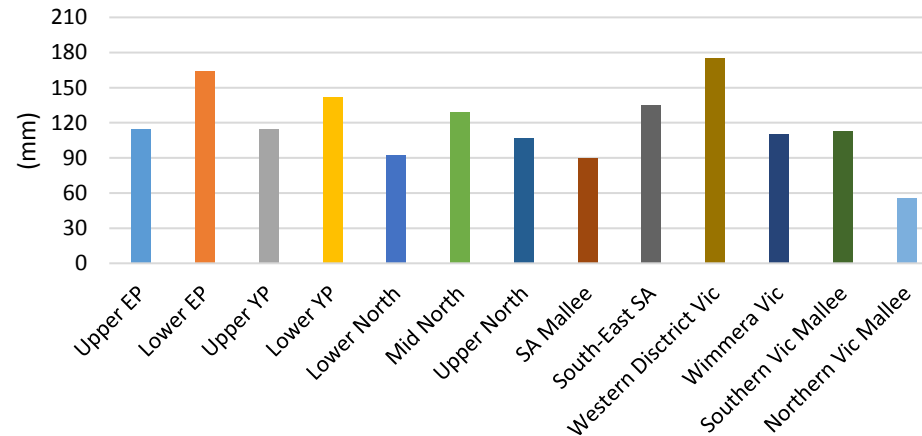
% of Monthly Average (Jun)



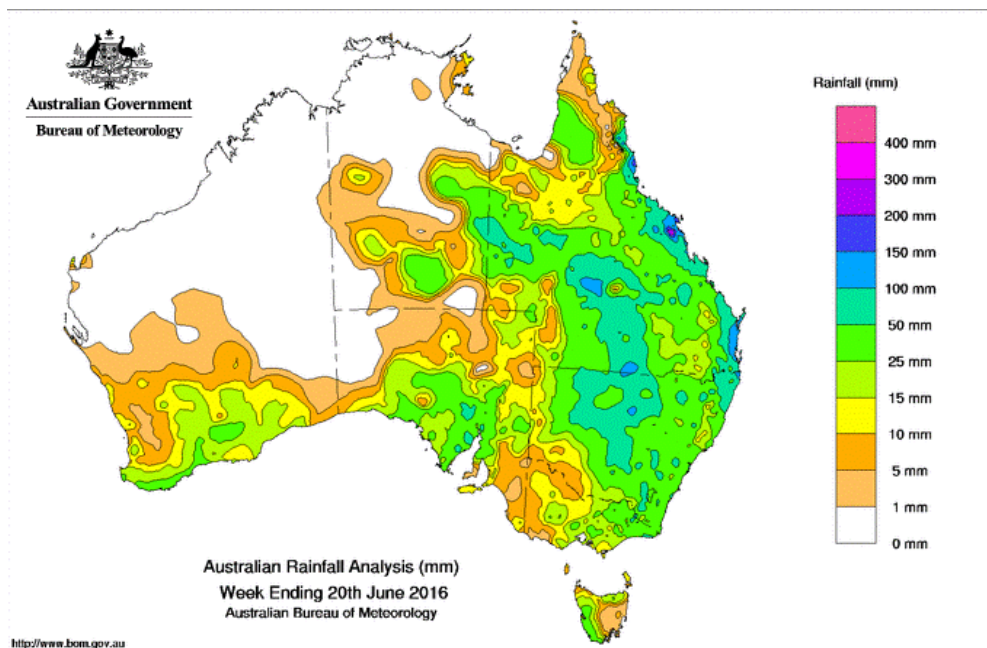
Monthly Rainfall (Jun)

Commentary

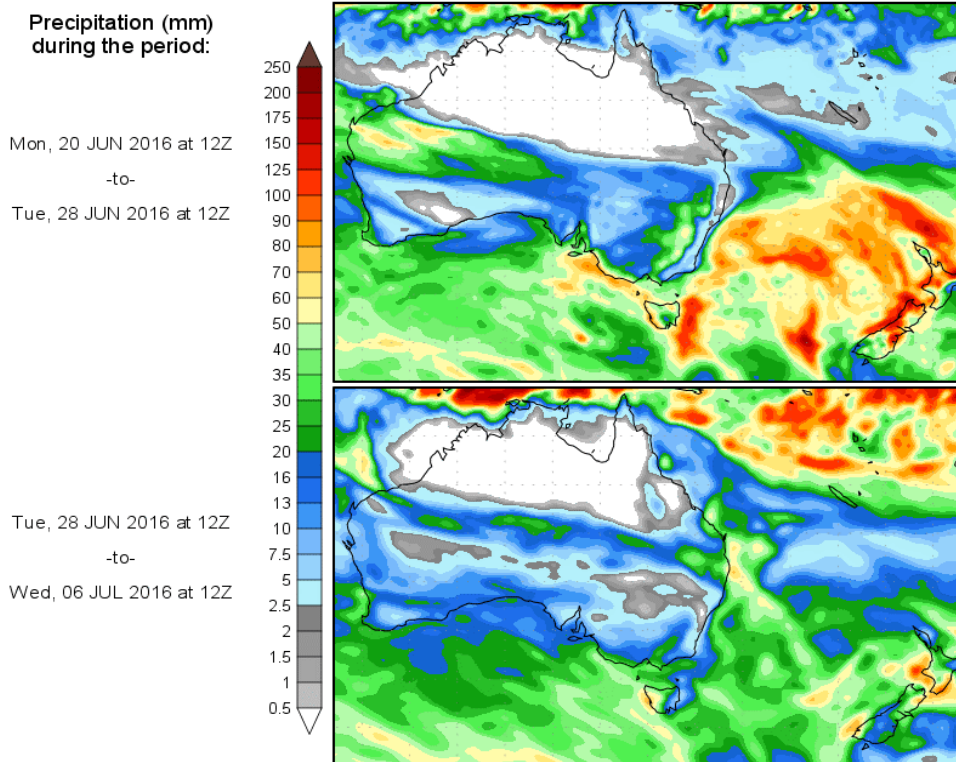
June has been a mixed month of rainfall for growing regions across SA & VIC. Precipitation across the EP, Upper YP, Mid & Upper North has already exceeded this month's average rainfall while in the Lower YP, SA Mallee and parts of Western Vic rainfall has not been as abundant. Last week's front brought meaningful rainfall to the EP and Lower, Mid & Upper North with some areas receiving almost 50mm. After May's above average moisture levels and June's continued deluge, growers' confidence in this year's production has been increasing.

The Bureau has forecast decent rain over the next week as a trough passes over both SA and WA. The Lower, Mid and Upper North and Yorke Peninsula could see more than 25mm while through the EP and Western Vic 10-20mm is expected. The BOM also continues to maintain a 50% chance of La Nina for 2016 for the period between June to August before returning to neutral during September. If this eventuates we could see continued above average rainfall for winter-spring.
